Activities and Social Events

Less than five minutes walk away, in one of Prince Henry's heritage-listed buildings, is the Little Bay Coast Centre for Seniors where there is always lots going on. Classes and activities include everything from French, Italian and Tai Chi to watercolour painting, bridge, scrabble and computers. Regular monthly events also include Market Day, Spring Fair, Speaker's Morning, Big Bands, Performance and Song, Dance and Drama Day. Some of our residents also enjoy singing in the choir. Shopping and Transport

There's plenty happening in the Prince Henry precinct too. A brand new shopping centre is planned for the corner of Pine Avenue and Anzac Parade, just a short walk from Little Bay Apartments. Construction is expected to be well underway in 2010. Many local retailers currently offer home delivery for our residents – including a supermarket, bottle shop, pharmacy and florist. The St Luke's bus takes residents on shopping trips to Bondi Junction, and Eastgardens is only a short drive away.



There is a regular bus service to Circular Quay; buses run approximately every 30 minutes. Should you require a taxi, our receptionist is always happy to book one for you.

More care is close at hand

Every apartment is equipped with emergency call buttons. With a duty officer on site 24/7, you know help is always at hand in the event of an emergency. If you should experience ill health and need more care, St Luke's will try to assist with Home Care if appropriate. The cost of Home Care is subsidised by the Government, subject to appropriate assessment by an Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT). St Luke's also provides non-subsidised care privately, for which ACAT assessment is not required.

There's a residential aged care facility approximately 500 metres from St Luke's Apartments at Little Bay. The facility offers various levels of care. As with all aged care facilities, admission requires an ACAT assessment.

Friends and family will love it here too

This really is the perfect place to experience a "sea change" in Sydney. Little Bay Beach is only 200 metres away. It's a protected sandy cove and swimming beach, very popular with visiting children and grandchildren. There are also beautiful coastal walks nearby.

The Coast Golf Club is a short walk from the apartment area. You don't need to be a golfer to enjoy the very reasonably-priced restaurant and bar with marvellous ocean views. Little Bay Apartments has pretty gardens with a barbecue, a herb garden and an outdoor residents' terrace.

Security around the clock

All our apartments are within a security building with an easy-to-use video intercom. You'll be able to use the intercom to see and talk to whomever is visiting you before buzzing them into the building. There's a duty officer on site 24 hours a day, seven days a week, so help is always available should you need it.
